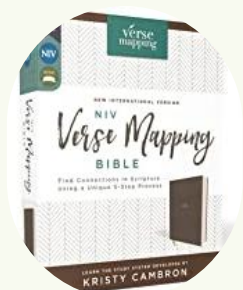

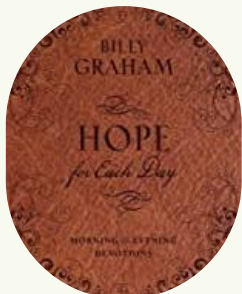


Sweet Selah Moments

The Christmas Bracelet

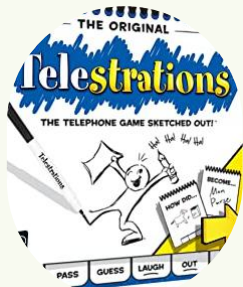
